Entitlement to a partner pension



Entitlement

In accordance with Art. 11 of the benefit regulations, in the case of the death of the insured person a partnership (also amongst persons of the same sex) establishes entitlement to a partner pension for the surviving partner if all of the conditions stated in the following are met:

1. the partners have verifiably and continuously lived together at least during the last five years before the death of the insured person.
2. both partners are unmarried at the time of the death.
3. the surviving partner is not related to the insured person in terms of Art. 100 of the Swiss Civil Code (ZGB).

Proof

Inter Pensionskasse only checks the entitlement to benefit after the death of the insured person. The entitlement to benefits has to be proved to Inter Pensionskasse by submitting the following documents:

- Proof that the two partners have verifiably and continuously lived together at least during the last five years before the death of the insured person (e.g. confirmation of the house share or tenancy agreement).
- Confirmation of the civil status of both partners.
- Divorce decree (if one or both partners is/are divorced).
